Her first professional year out of college was with the LA Current ISL team for the end of season meets. In the 2020 season, she had a breakout ISL season with Energy Standard.

She was officially diagnosed with depression and anxiety the summer of 2016, and ended up leaving UT and the sport to get professional help after a near suicide attempt in 2017. She came back from treatment with a new passion for life and swimming. Returning to swimming was a challenge in itself, but she was relentless and came back stronger than ever to become a captain her senior year. After her last NCAAs, she left the sport, ready to move on to her next chapter, but after 3 months of normal life, she felt called back to the water. She had so much more to give to the sport. She returned to pool with the fire ignited once again, and is now training full time in Knoxville, TN.
