After trying other sports like gymnastics, karate and dancing, Dagmara was hooked on fencing after her first class.

"Fencing has brought me so much. I've made lifelong friends, nationally and internationally. It has taught me so much about myself as a person—how to apply myself, how to lose, how to pick myself back up. It has taught me planning, goal-setting—it has taught me more than school, college, anything..."

Dagmara is actively training for the Tokyo 2020 Olympics and is currently the #1 ranked female fencer in the US. She also speaks at schools and to young girls and women about body positivity and determination.
